NV	Marquis de la Tour, Brut	Loire, France	\$28
	<i>A nice mousse, crispness, and an apple, bready, creamy palate with nuances of citrus and nuts. There's a lot of baked bread aromas in this delightful bubbly, along with peach pie and even apricot.</i>		
NV	Marquis de la Tour, Rose	Loire, France	\$28
	<i>Fine bubbles accompany this delicate and elegant sparkler from the Loire Valley. Notes of strawberry and raspberries surround this round, fresh wine. Cabernet Franc, Syrah and Grenache.</i>		
NV	Schramsberg Mirabelle Non-Vintage	California	\$36
	<i>Elegant and toasty aromas lead into crisp and complex flavors on the palate. A bright citrus entry gives way to subtle honey and caramel. Unique blend of grapes from Napa, Sonoma, and Mendocino.</i>		
NV	J Cuvee 20 Brut Non-Vintage	Russian River Valley	\$47
	<i>This brut opens up with crisp lemon peel, honeysuckle and delicate yeast aromas. This will flow into a mix of Fuji apple and grapefruit mixed with acidity to create a warm pear and lush finish.</i>		
2006	Schramsberg Cremant	Napa Valley	\$70
	<i>Delicious aromas of ripe mango and pineapple are followed by developed flavors of sweet peach, juicy orange and are rounded by roasted hazelnut.</i>		
NV	Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin, Brut	Reims, France	\$99
	<i>Aromas of lemon, currant, clove and mint. Fresh and frothy, with a strong mousse and a distinctly floral impression to go along with berry flavors.</i>		
2002	Dom Perignon, Moet & Chandon	Epernay, France	\$250
	<i>Fresh, crystalline, and sharp. This champagne features secret touches of white pepper and gardenia. Notes of dried ginger linger on the palate with ripe tropical fruits. The finish is smooth and mellow.</i>		
1998	Tattinger, Blanc de Blancs Comtes de Champagne	Reims, France	\$272
	<i>Impressive and seamless from the start, featuring lemon, apricot, smoke and spice aromas. This is creamy yet firm & fresh, with all its elements integrated for an alluring profile overall.</i>		
2002	Louis Roederer, Cristal	Reims, France	\$300
	<i>This is an exceptional wine, as is the vintage. The fruits-grapefruit, crisp red apple-balance with a fine yeasty character. There is a great depth of flavor, the fruits going in a pure line of freshness.</i>		
2002	Perrier Jouet Fleur, Rose Champagne	Epernay, France	\$350
	<i>A refined fruity bouquet of peonies and roses, are followed by subtle berry notes of wild strawberries and raspberries. On the palate, a harmony of fresh air and silk texture.</i>
